

Call for Papers --- Technology for Earth Observation

Earthzine.org, an IEEE-sponsored online scientific journal, is soliciting articles of 800-1,500 words for the **“2013 Earth Science Technology Showcase,”** an online presentation of technology developments for the Earth science community.

The Showcase aims to highlight the latest advances in Earth observation technology via remote sensing instruments, platforms, components, advanced information systems, sensor web technologies, communications, automation, and modeling.

Principal investigators from the NASA Earth Science Technology Office (ESTO) are invited to participate, along with ESTO team members, collaborators, and students.

Articles should be of interest to the expert while being accessible to the non-specialist. A panel of student judges will select the best submissions and top authors will receive a plaque and certificate commemorating their accomplishment. The Showcase will be similar to [Virtual Poster Sessions](#) previously hosted by Earthzine.

This Showcase is separate from a first 2014 quarterly theme on [Earth Science Informatics Challenges](#), and a Student Essay Contest on [Science Technology for Observing Earth's Climate](#).

Important dates: Showcase submissions must be in English, and will be accepted until **Oct. 1, 2013**. Submit inquiries and articles to Guest Editor Phil Larkin via ESTO@earthzine.org.

Publication: All accepted contributions will [undergo review](#) by subject-matter experts, be published online at Earthzine.org, beginning Nov. 16, 2013, and be freely accessible to the public. Earthzine does not charge authors for publishing.
